It's YOUR choice.

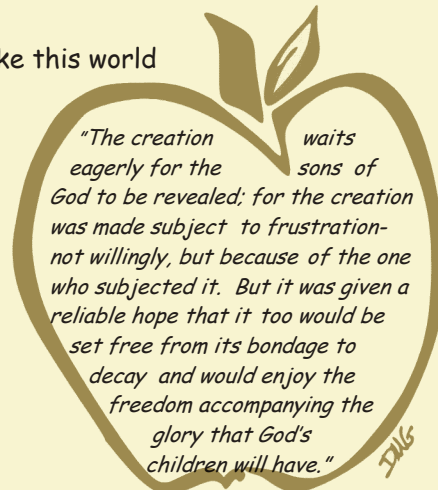
Be ready with a Word...

A Word from the Torah...

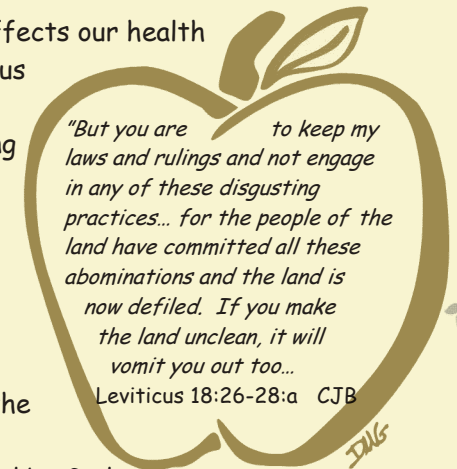
There are many important rules in this week's parsha about how to keep your body holy unto the Lord. God gives us these rules for our own good.

He shows us that being obedient affects our health and our environment. God reminds us that he has given us a beautiful land to live in when we live according to His laws. In fact, listen to this interesting piece of Torah...

God is saying something really important here! God tells us that the land we live in is a gift from Him.

We've been entrusted with that land by God.



As Jewish believers in Messiah Yeshua, we know the land God promised to us is Israel. We have been given that land as a trust, because we agree to live according to God's laws.

And yet, the land you live in now is yours to take care of too, even if it's just for a while. The whole earth is God's creation, and He made us able to enjoy it and to care for it.

Hmmm, now think about this...

Do you try to help keep our neighborhoods clean. Do you take time to enjoy this beautiful world God gave us to enjoy?

We must pray that all the Jews in Israel follow Torah and receive God's blessing of living in Eretz Israel again.

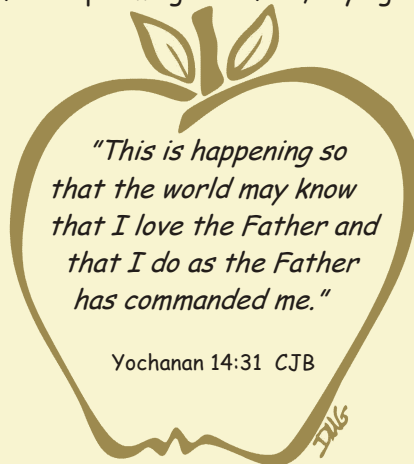
We must pray that the blindness is lifted from the eyes of our Jewish bretheren so that they all can see Messiah Yeshua!
