
# A Word to live by ...

## Parshat Tazria - "Conceived" Yeshua Restores!

### A Word from the Torah...

This week's parsha seems a bit unusual. It gives God's priests specific instructions about how to inspect skin diseases to help people stay healthy and not pass the illness on to another person. It almost sounds like the priests also acted like doctors back then.

We have a lot more medicines available now that make it possible to fight infection. Back then, though, medicines were more scarce and infected people just had to stay away until they got better. By staying away from others, they kept disease from spreading throughout the camp.

"Everyone who has tzara'at sores is to wear torn clothes and unbound hair, cover his upper lip and cry 'Unclean! Unclean!' As long as he has sores, he will be unclean, he must live in isolation; he must live outside the camp." Leviticus 13:45 & 46

### CHECK OUT THE

Can you imagine that? This poor guy is sick. Instead of being able to snuggle up in his bed and be given chicken soup by his mom and get visits from his concerned friends...

He has to leave his home and live outside in the wilderness ALONE until he's better! Plus, if he DOES see any people, he has to warn them to stay away from him!



### Hmmm, now think about this...

Wouldn't he feel lonely and sad? Aren't you thankful to God that you have people in your life that help you when you're sick instead of kicking you out?!

And, what about his home... his job... his dog? How long would he have to wait to get his life back?

#### A Word from Yeshua...

In Yeshua's day, these sick people would have to stay away from their loved ones a long time, sometimes forever.

When Messiah Yeshua was walking the earth, he performed many miracles. He multiplied food, he walked on water, he silenced a storm, and he raised the dead! Miracles followed Him everywhere.

ry an willing cleansed Sick people started looking for Him. They knew that He could heal them. For some of them, Yeshua was their ONLY hope. They were desperate!

In the book of Mattiyahu, chapter 8, there is a story about a man with leprosy. Leprosy is a serious skin disease that is contagious and, even today, has no medical cure. This is serious, This man lost his whole life and family when he got sick. He went to Yeshua, knelt before him and ASKED Him to heal him.

#### CHECK OUT THE

This man's whole life changed in an instant! Yeshua had the power to heal this man and give him his life back. The sickness that ruined his life was OVFR

He could return to his home. He could return to his family. He could return to his job. He could return to his future!

Mattiyahu 8:3b CJB When this man met Yeshua, and believed in

the power that Yeshua had to change his life... EVERYTHING CHANGED!
