We can skip buying an extra dessert at lunch and put those coins in the tzedaka box!

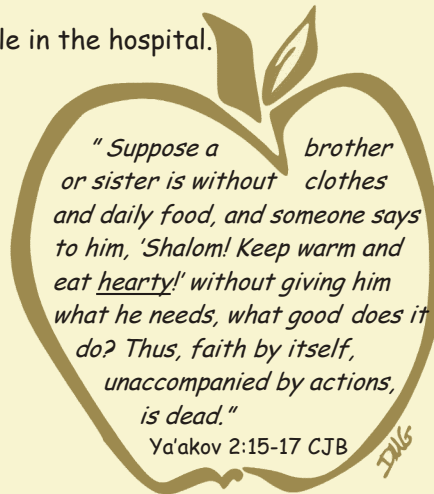
Be ready with a Word...

"Sure! God gives us more than enough to give away!"



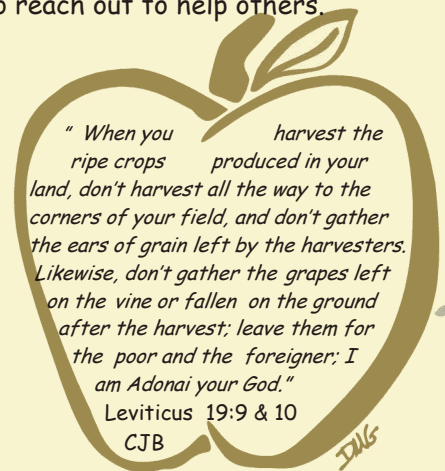

A Word from the Torah...

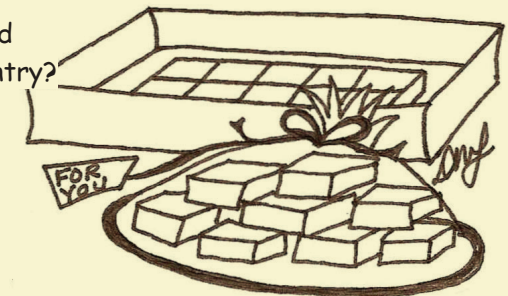
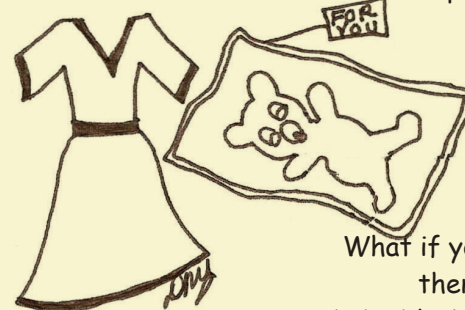
In this week's parsha God wants to teach us about being gracious and merciful. When we are motivated out of love for God, it is very natural to want to reach out to help others. God gives us specific instructions about how to do just that.

By leaving some of our harvest unpicked and ungathered, we leave food to help the poor and needy among us. Now, since most of us are not farmers, can you think of other ways to fulfill this scripture?



What if you made a batch of brownies, and you gathered all the edge squares together on a plate and delivered them to the local food pantry?



What if you used a bolt of fabric to sew a dress, then used the rest of the fabric to make a baby blanket for a sick child in the local hospital?

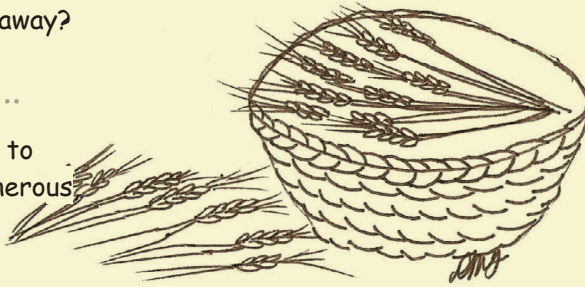
Hmmm, now think about this...

It is merciful to show kindness to others. God wants us to be generous because He gives us more than enough to give away!

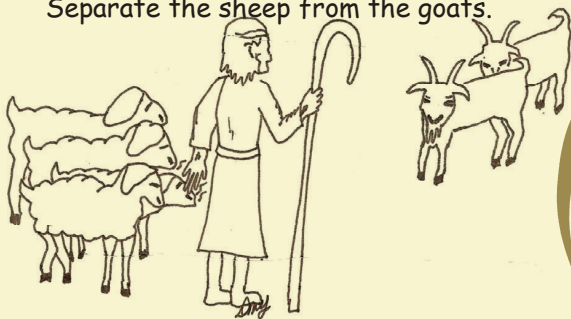


Messiah Yeshua tells an interesting story about it in Mattityahu, chapter 25. Be sure to read it!

Yeshua warns us of the day of His return when he is coming to find His followers waiting for Him. How will He tell who follows Him? This is how Yeshua describes His followers, His "SHEEP"! CHECK OUT THE 🍏

Yeshua is looking for those who show God's love and mercy to others. Yeshua calls the people that don't help others -"GOATS".

When Yeshua returns, He will Separate the sheep from the goats.
