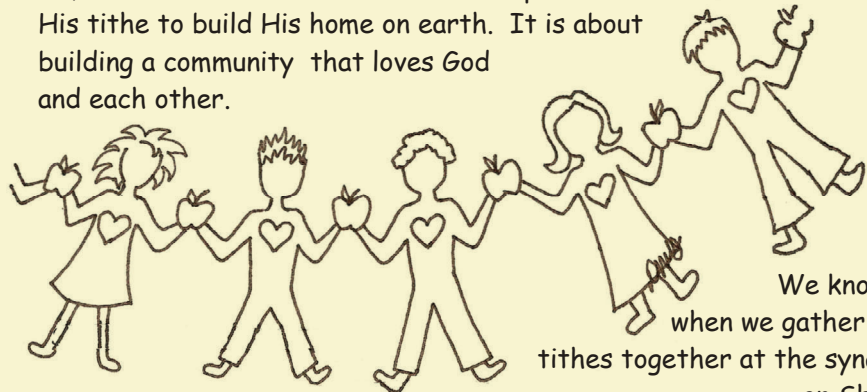


A Word to live by...

A Word from the Torah...

Everything we have belongs to God. The food we eat comes from Him, because He's the One that makes it grow. The money your parents make at their jobs belongs to Him because their health is in God's hands.

Even your homework belongs to Him because He's the one that gave you your fabulous brain power to do it!

So, how do we say "thank you"
To God? CHECK OUT THE 🍏

*"All the tenth given from
the land, whether from
planted seed or fruit from
trees, belongs to Adonai."*

Leviticus 27:30 CJB

God commands in this week's
Parsha that one tenth, called
a "tithe," belongs to Him.

That means that God wants a
dime back for every dollar He
gives you the strength to earn.

That means He wants one apple
for every ten apples that you pick.

That means He wants you to give
one sock for every ten socks you knit.

What does God need all
that money and stuff for?



Hmmm, now think about this...

If God owns everything, why does He need some of it back? What does He need it for? Doesn't it all belong to Him already?

Why do we have to give Him anything? (First off, that sounds a little ungrateful, doesn't it?)

A Word from Yeshua...

Giving a tithe to the Lord is an act of obedience, a chance to show Him that we will do as He says. He gives us the CHOICE to return it to Him.

In fact, being able to give back to God, when you want to keep it for yourself, tells a lot about what is really in your heart. Look what Messiah Yeshua has to say about it... CHECK OUT THE 🍏

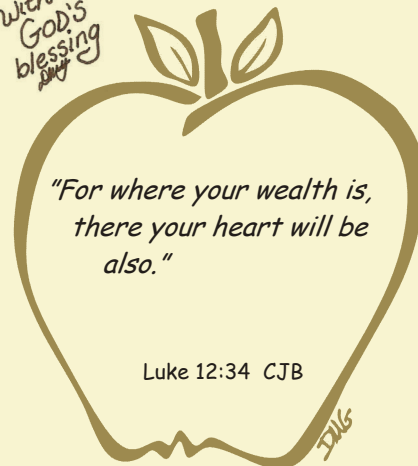
God uses the tithe to help us to check our hearts. We obey God because we love Him. When we give to God, we are supposed to do it cheerfully.

Tithing with a happy heart shows that you TRUST God. You are trusting Him to make the 90% left over to stretch even farther than if you had kept the whole 100% to yourself. How does that work?

SUPERNATURAL "GOD MATH"
"LESS" without GOD's blessing 100% < 90% "MORE" with GOD's blessing

Tithing is a spiritual law, just like gravity is a physical law... If you throw a ball up in the air, IT WILL FALL. If you give God 10%, THEN 90% WILL GO FARTHER THAN 100%!

We are trusting Him to take care of our needs!
