A Word from the Torah...

Every single person is important to God. God knows exactly who is born to whom... it happens exactly the way He plans it.
In this week's parsha... CHECK OUT THE 🍏

The word "genealogy" is the study of "family trees."
All throughout the Torah we see how God pays attention to the growth of His people through the recording of their births. In fact, back then, no one had a separate last name, you would be known by the name of your father and your clan.

For example, You know that King Da'vid was the father of King Shlomo? And, Yishai was the father of King Da'vid?

Plus, you know that the kings of Israel were all from the tribe of Judah. So, King Shlomo would have been called (in Hebrew)... Shlomo ben David ben Yishai of the tribe of Yehuda!

What would your Hebrew name be?

Remember that you use "ben" for "son" and "bat" for "daughter!"

"...that in union with the Messiah and through the Good News the Gentiles were to be joint heirs, a joint body and joint sharers with the Jews in what God has promised."
Ephesians 3:6 CJB

"...they gathered the whole assembly to state their genealogies by families and clans and recorded the names of all those twenty years old and over, as well as their total numbers. Moses counted them in the Sinai desert, just as Adonai had ordered them."

Hmmm, now think about this...

Do you know who Yeshua's earthly parents were? In fact, it gives the lineage of BOTH His birth mother, Miriam bat Heli, and His earthly father, Yosef ben Yaacov.

Did you know that both Yeshua's earthly parents are descendants of King Da'vid - just like the prophecies promised us! Do you know where to find this in the Bible? Why is it important to know where to find it?

A Word from Yeshua...

You can find the lineage of Miriam in the Gospel of Luke and the lineage of Yosef in the Gospel of Mattityahu.

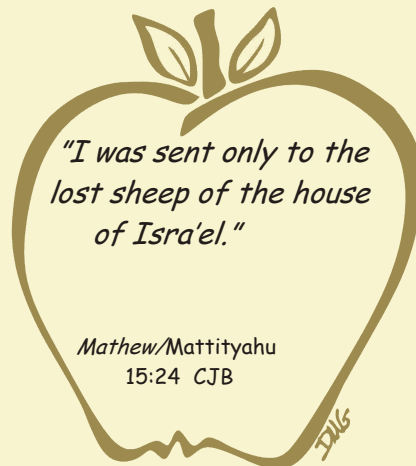
The Jews had been waiting a long time for one of King David's descendants to be the promised Messiah! So, can you imagine how strange it must be for a Jewish person to read the Brit Chadasha for the VERY FIRST time?

What?! This "New Testament" has their own King Da'vid, and Father Avraham... what is this, some crazy parallel universe I stepped into?

Wait!! Jesus was a Jew?! He was circumcised on the eighth day? He studied Torah...went to temple...Celebrated the Holy days? YES!

Yeshua (Jesus) was such an observant Jew that He, Himself proclaimed:

Yet, many Gentiles were changed Through Yeshua's earthly ministry. Yeshua was amazed at their faith. Some Gentiles believed Him even though they were never taught about waiting for His help. *That really touched Yeshua's heart and moved Him with compassion.*
