A Word to live by...

Think about Noach, after 40 days and nights of endless rain... There were no people left, no land, no food... what now?

Can you imagine how relieved he was when that dove returned to him with an olive <u>branch</u>? That meant that somewhere there was a tree, and land... and hope to begin again. CHECK OUT THE

A Word from the Torah...

This week's Parsha contains the most well known blessing of all... CHECK OUT THE $\textcircled{\begin{tabular}{ll}}$

Aharon and his sons were commanded by God to bless the children of Israel with these words. Even today, our Rabbi's bless us at the end of the service with exactly this blessing.

It is very comforting to know God wants to <u>smile</u> upon us and be good to us. And, even though we know it, it's still nice to hear it often. It can bring peace to a <u>troubled</u> heart.

"May Adonai bless you and keep you. May Adonai make His face <u>shine</u> on you and show you His favor. May Adonai lift up His face toward you and give you peace." Numbers 6:24-26 CJB



Next time you see a friend in trouble, you could remember to bless him that way. That's called "ministering" to someone. That's what it means to be a priest or <u>cohen</u>, an ambassador for God.



Hmmm, now think about this...

Did you know that one of the names for Israel's Messiah can be found in Yeshiyahu 9 where He is called the <u>Prince</u> of Peace or "*Sar Shalom?*"


Does that make <u>Adonai</u> the ruler of our hearts when we let Him fill us with His peace? How can He help make us peaceful? How can we let Him do that?

A Word from Yeshua...

Yeshua has an answer coming that you just don't see yet...


