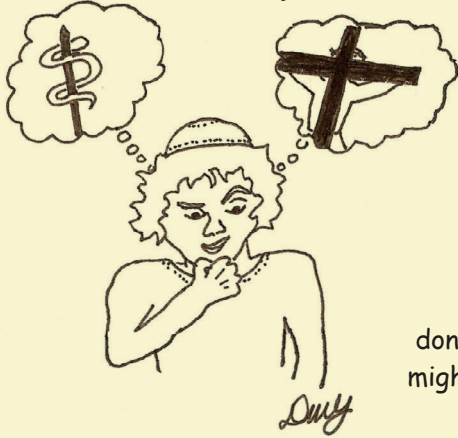


A Word to live by...

Look at Yeshua and live!

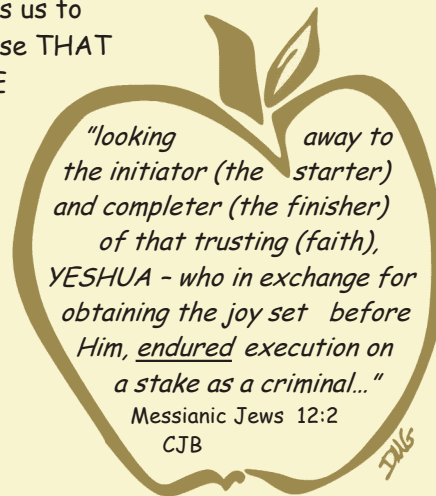
Be ready with a Word...

"His sacrifice paid for our sin... Look at Yeshua and live!"

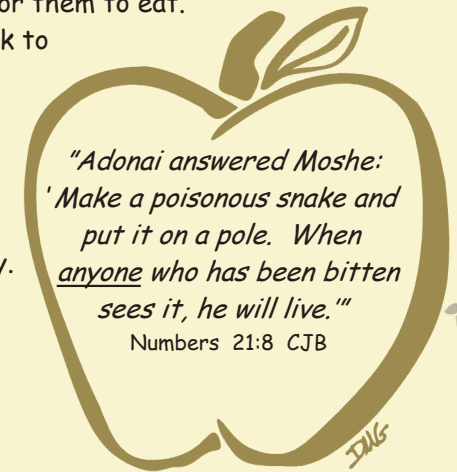
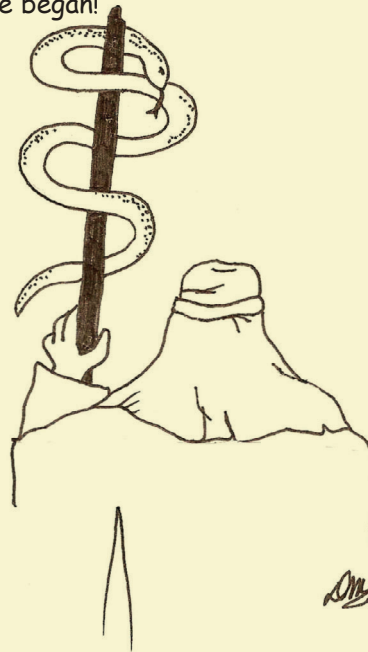


Parshat Chukat- "Ordinances" Look At Yeshua and Live!

A Word from the Torah...

The time has come to begin entering the promised land. God has taken care of the Israelites, guiding them day by day. God has provided manna and quail for them to eat. He even commanded Moshe to speak to a rock, which caused water to pour forth and quench their thirst!

But, again, the Israelites complained against Adonai. Their complaining made Adonai very angry. He sent venomous snakes to bite and kill the grumblers among them. Everywhere around them, the plague began!



The Israelites begged Moshe to pray to Adonai to stop the plague!

So, Moshe did as the Adonai commanded. He made a bronze snake on a pole, and as surely as God spoke it, **EVERY** person who looked at the snake **LIVED!**

The plague was stopped!

Hmmm, now think about this...

God stopped the plague by making them look at the same thing that they were afraid of! Why did God do that?

Why couldn't they look at a mongoose (they eat snakes) or an elephant (they crush snakes)? Why did they have to look at a snake? And how did just looking at it make someone LIVE, instead of die?

A Word from Yeshua...

This story in the Parsha is referred to as a "type and shadow." God uses this story to show us a "type" of thing He does to show us a "shadow" of what is coming next. It's kind of like a clue to a mystery!

Just think about this, the Israelites were dying all around because of their grumbling. When Moshe fashioned that bronze snake, like a blacksmith would, he had to trust God that it would work.

Then the Israelites had to BELIEVE God would save their lives if they just LOOKED at it! Does that idea sound familiar to you? Does something like that still work today?

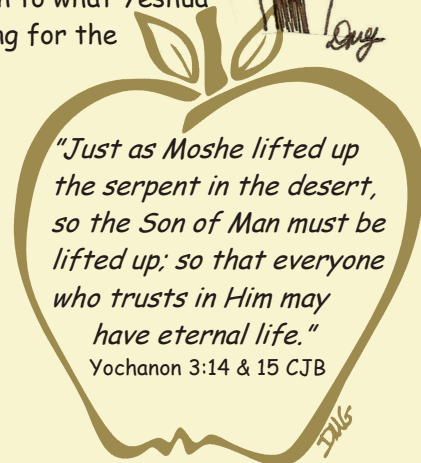
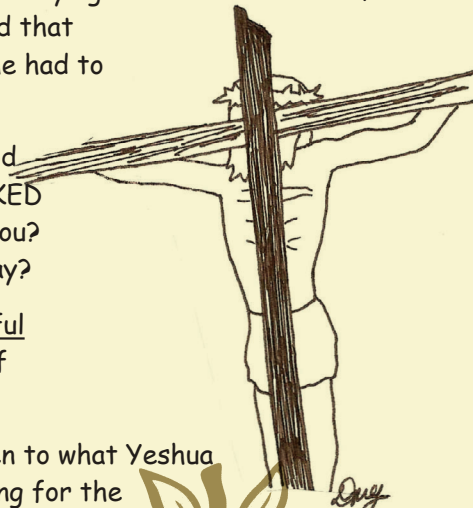
Is looking and believing God still powerful enough to stop death caused by sin? Of course it is... **Just look at YESHUA!**

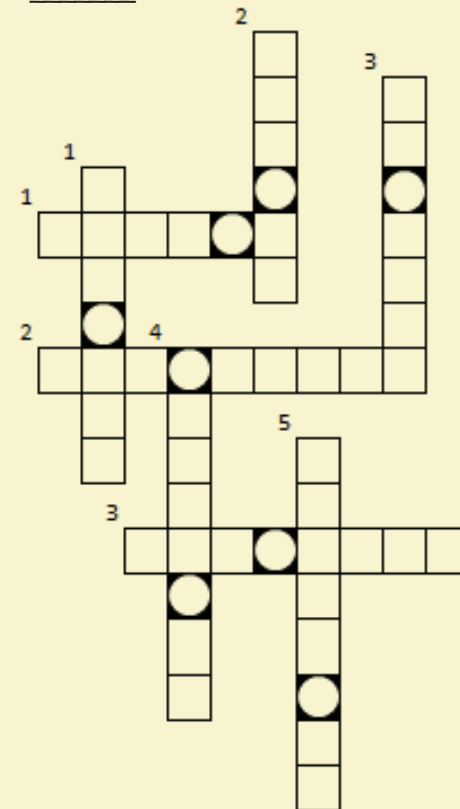
