A Word to live by ...

Well, there is one more VERY IMPORTANT <u>quality</u> that every Godly leader needs. Moshe had it... Y'hoshua had it... The three women had it!

David had it, too! David wrote about it in the <u>Psalms</u>:

CHECK OUT THE

David drew near the Lord in <u>worship</u>. The women waiting outside Yeshua's tomb were missing His presence in their lives.

The thing all Godly leaders have in common is that they LOVE the presence of God! They love to bask in God's glory. They love to worship Him!

So, was Y'hoshua like that, too?

Maybe the <u>greatest</u> thing we know about Y'hoshua was that it says in Torah thatHe stayed behind, in God's Presence, even after Moshe left the Tent of Meeting. Y'hoshua LOVED <u>staying</u>

where God's presence dwelled - where His Glory stayed. He loved to worship.

LEADERS MUST LOVE GOD'S PRESENCE- HIS GLORY!


Be ready with a Word...

A Word from the Torah...

The Israelites are about to receive their land <u>inheritance</u>. Aharon has died and El'azar, his son, is the new Cohen Hagadol (High Priest.) Moshe is getting old and Adonai says it is time to pick a new <u>leader</u> for the people. Who would Adonai choose?

Why Y'hoshua? Do you remember Y'hoshua? What do we know about him?

Most recently, we should remember that he was one of the two spies that <u>brought</u> back a good report about the promised land. We remember that Y'hoshua had "eyes of faith" that helped him believe when most of the others' faith failed.

"Adonai said to
Moshe, 'Take Y'hoshua, the
son of Nun, a spiritual man,
and lay your hand on him. Put
him in front of El'azar the
cohen and the whole
assembly and commission
him in their sight."
Numbers, 28:18 & 19

LEADERS MUST HAVE FAITH

Y'hoshua was Moshe's aide, going with him to Mount Sinai, going with him to the Tent of Meeting and being his legs by leading the Israelites into war.

And even amongst all the grumbling of the Israelites, Y'hoshua never rebelled Against the Lord or Moshe. He was faithful and obedient.

LEADERS MUST BE GOOD SERVANTS



Hmmm, now think about this...

Wasn't Y'hoshua the one who saw all the <u>miracles</u> while he was serving Moshe? Was he learning to trust God like Moshe did? Do you think Y'hoshua was willing to give all his <u>strength</u> to see God's promises fulfilled? What an honor. It must have been awesome and yet scary at the same time. How would you feel?

A Word from Yeshua...

As believers in Yeshua, we LEAD people to the Lord by <u>sharing</u> the PROMISE of everlasting life with them.

When we obey God by sharing the gospel message, we have to believe God's promise will work in that person's life to <u>restore</u> their soul and make their life better.

Trusting that God can help us is very hard sometimes. Do you remember the story of Lazarus, Miriam's brother? He was dead three days and Miriam was so sad! Then Yeshua came saying... CHECK OUT THE

Many people saw Lazarus rise from the dead, including the talmidim and the women who traveled with Yeshua. Can you imagine, after Yeshua's death, how difficult it was for Yeshua's followers to have hope?

After they <u>waited</u> three long, dark days (kind of like Miriam waiting for Yeshua after Lazarus had died), Yeshua appeared to three women outside the tomb! He had risen!

The three women were the <u>first</u> to see Him! They acted like LEADERS bringing the good news to His talmidim!

How do we LEAD others to the Good News of Yeshua?

Leading people to the Lord needs trust and confidence that He is REAL and really does help those who call on Him. So how do we do it? How do we stay confident? How do we stay full of faith?
