A Word from the Torah...

This week's parsha makes the requirements for God's people very clear. God wants to make a covenant, a <u>MUTUAL</u> commitment, with the Israelites. What began in last week's parsha, the Ten Commandments, now includes a full set of <u>LAWS</u> and regulations to <u>GOVERN</u> this new nation.

Moshe brings all these "words" to the people. This is the way they can choose to FOLLOW God. If they agree to make this covenant with God, God himself promises to bless them, care for them and PROTECT them. He promises to make them His treasured possession - thereby fulfilling His promise to their father. Avraham.

"This is the blood of the COVENANT which Adonai has made with you in accordance with all these words."

Exodus 24:7 & 8 CJB

The Israelites agreed to the TERMS of the covenant, saying....



The Israelites SACRIFICED young bulls before Adonai to <u>CONFIRM</u> the covenant they were making in accordance with God's requirements and Moshe sprinkled a portion of that blood on the crowd of people, saying: CHECK OUT THE
