Spending time in His Word (the Bible) is a great way to start!

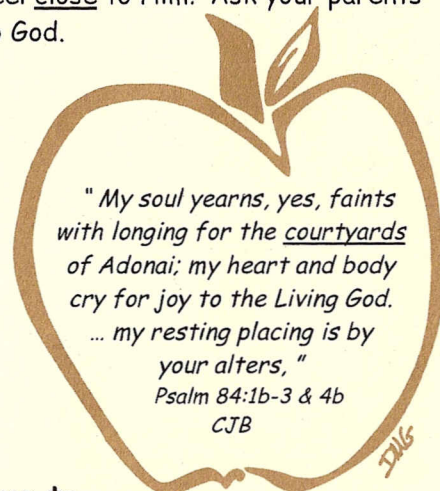
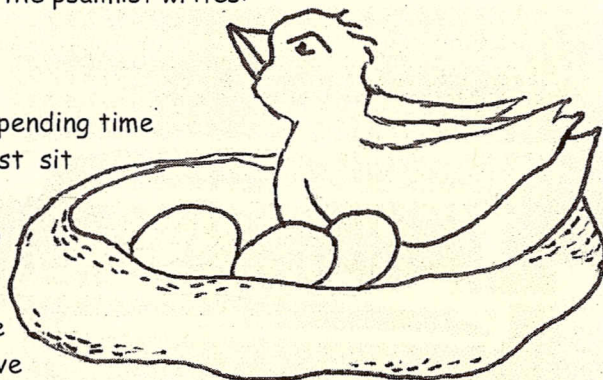
Be ready with a Word...

A Word from the Torah...

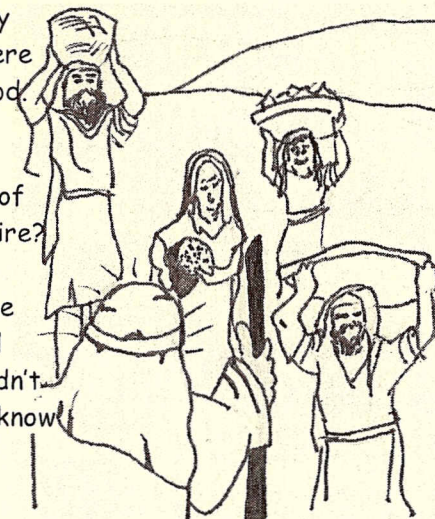
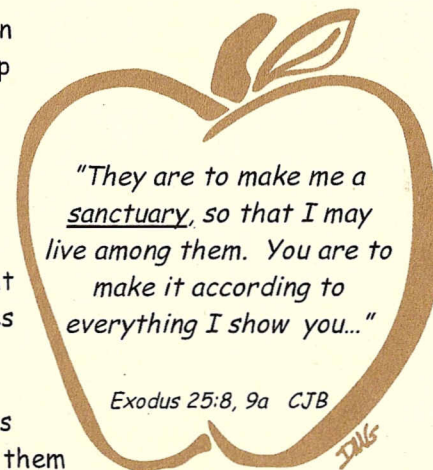
The Israelites have made a covenant to follow God. Moshe now has to train these people to follow the God they cannot see or touch. How will they find Him?

God commanded Moshe to take up an offering to build a PLACE to worship Him. God gives Moses very specific instructions. CHECK OUT THE 🍎

The people began bringing Moshe their gold and silver. They brought animal skins and wood. They brought thread and spices. All the Israelites gave generously from their hearts.

They were excited about giving gifts to this invisible God that had saved them from slavery in Egypt. They had watched the Egyptians worship many idols, they knew there had to be a way to follow a God of their own. They were eager to make a place to find their God.

This invisible God of the Israelites existed in a cloud by day and a pillar of fire by night. How could they hug a fire? How could they draw a cloud? How could they talk to him? Would they be able to see Him smile or scowl? Could they learn to trust the God they couldn't touch or feel? How would they ever know they had found His FAVOR?

Wherever you go...

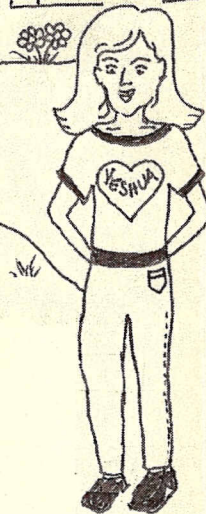
Yeshua says: CHECK OUT THE

The God of Israel only really wants one thing from us. He wants a relationship with each of us. He wants us to love Him like He loves us. He wants us, His creation, to want to spend time with Him like He wants to spend time with us.

He promised in last week's Parsha to walk in covenant with us. This week, he begins to give us a pattern to do just that. That pattern begins with a meeting place to come together with God. At first, this starts with a physical place... a tabernacle.

The key to having that place inside you is loving Yeshua!
