
A Word to live by ...

Parshat Tetzaveh - "You Shall Command" A Kingdom of Priests

A Word from the Toron

Now that the plans for the Tabernacle had been delivered to the people, God commanded Moshe to set the Levites apart as a nation of priests to serve in the His holy tabernacle. Another word for "set apart" is to "sanctify."

God commanded that Moshe sanctify Aharon as the chief priest to minister to Adonai, day and night. God gave this command to sanctify His priests:

CHECK OUT THE

Doesn't that sound wild? Why would God tell them to do that? Since blood makes atonement for sin, what was God trying to show them about their physical bodies? Why did He choose those places... ears, hands and feet?

toes of their right feet ... "


right hands and the big

Hmmm, now think about this...

Why do you think the priests had to behave in a way that pleased God? What would it be like if a priests went around yelling at people with his mouth or hitting them with his hands?

Is that a good example of a person that is supposed to be close to God? Isn't that one of the reasons God sent us Yeshua, to be a better example?

A Word from Yeshua ...

We are not God. We fall short of God's glory all the time. God is holy! To come into His presence, we need to be holy, too. How can we be holy?

The good <u>news</u> is that Messiah Yeshua, the son of the Living God, came to earth in the form of a man to lay down His own life so that we might be saved from death and find the way to eternal life.

Yeshua became our Passover sacrifice. His blood pays for our sins. CHECK OUT THE ●

He became our final High Priest. The blood of animals is no longer necessary to cover our sins, Yeshua's blood is enough... forever. It's this price He paid that makes us holy.

Don't forget, the priests were called to minister to God, day and night in the tabernacle. They needed to be sanctified and "set apart" for God's use. They were called to serve the people and help them get close to God, too. God wants to be close to all His people.
